Student Ministries Intern Responsibilities:

- Model Gospel-centered relational ministry by visiting students where they are and providing counsel as needed
- Visit and minister to local High Schools or Jr. Highs and serve as the point person for mobilizing student-led ministry at the school
 - Be a visible presence at sporting events (2x/month)
 - Support CF students who attend the school in an effort to invite their friends to ministry functions
 - Create before or after school gatherings to encourage Christian community within the context of the school (1x/month)
- Commit to weekly discipleship and training facilitated by Ministry Coaches
- Plan and execute weekly Student Ministries programming for Sunday morning, Sunday night and mid-week services (Tuesday Evenings)
- Perform administrative tasks and communication for Student Ministries
- Aid in the recruitment of future Interns and/or volunteers
- Attend Community Fellowship Church as an active participant of the church body

Summer Intern Responsibilities:

- Model a Gospel-centered lifestyle that glorifies God and demonstrates faith in Jesus Christ
- Plan and organize weekly ministry tasks as well as administrative duties for the ministry you are responsible for
- Commit to weekly discipleship by pastors and ministry leaders
- Commit to weekly leadership classes and complete all reading and writing assignments with excellence
- Organize and lead College Ministry (1x/week)
- Attend Community Fellowship Church as an active participant of the church body

Learn the art of leadership: Throughout the program, leadership training will be taught by seasoned pastors and ministry leaders. Using scripture as our guide, the team will study significant portions of Titus and 1 Timothy to learn the art of pastoral leadership. In addition you will attend two conferences as a team to grow in your knowledge and competency as a Christian leader.

Explore your gifts for ministry: The LEAD program is designed as a training ground for discovering your God-given gifts. As an intern, you will be given a customized job description that will provide you with the opportunity to practice your skills while exploring and developing additional areas of interest.

Advance in essential ministry skills: You will be provided hands-on training in the area of your gifting and passion. You will have the opportunity to practice and hone your skills while developing other abilities that will challenge you to grow. Our desire is to equip you to use your gifts to serve the Church and give glory to God.
